A huge thank you to Ms Lasisz for organising the events as well as the Fairview staff and the Year 6 students for helping with all the set up and smooth running of the event.

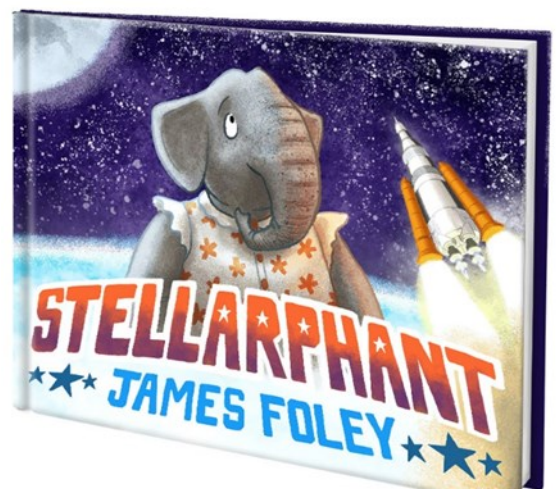
Fairview P&C

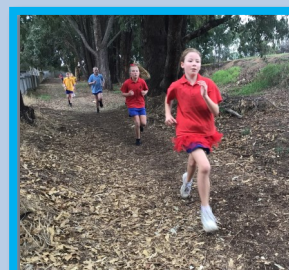

- ⇒ Changing schools

Apply to enrol your child for 2026

Closing date: 23 July 2025

If you or anyone you know has a child born between 1 July 2021–30 June 2022, they are eligible to attend kindergarten. Enrolment packages are available from the office.

A copy of your child's birth certificate and immunisation record will be required.

Please note – students enrolled in kindy this year will receive paperwork in the coming weeks to enrol for Pre-Primary next year.
