WA Student Assistance Payment

The WA State Government is very keen for every family to claim their 2025 Student Assistance Payment. Your time to make the claim is running out! All claims must be submitted by the last day of term, Friday 4 July. All students from Kindy to Year 12 who are enrolled in a WA public school, non-government school or are registered for home education in Pre-primary to Year 12 are eligible for this payment.

The fastest way to apply is through the Services WA app. This is a fast and easy process, and payment is usually received in a few days. You will need your child's WA Student Number, which is printed on every school report they receive. If you have trouble finding this, please contact the school.

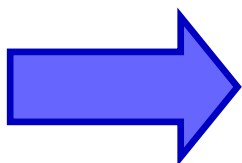
Check for library books

A message from School Dental Services

SCHOOL DENTAL SERVICE, IT'S TIME TO ENROL!

Every year Dental Health Services (DHS) offers parents and carers the chance to register their kids for free dental care at the School Dental Service (SDS). The offer is open to every student from the year they turn 5 until their 17th birthday and includes check-ups, fillings, and simple extractions.

Your child will soon bring home an enrolment form, Frequently Asked Questions, and reply-paid envelope from DHS. Just fill in the enrolment form, pop it in the reply-paid envelope, and put it in your nearest post box.

Once we receive your form at DHS our team will register your child and arrange for you to receive an appointment in the mail.
